The minutes from the meeting dated May 12, 2020 were presented and approved. Lacy Pearce moved to approve and Michelle Robertson second the motion.

1.0 Staffing

- We are a little above projection with students. Students in each grade level not including Self Contained K- 67 Students, 1st- 67 Students, 2nd- 56 Students, 3rd- 70 Students, 4th- 64 Students, 5th- 76 Students
- With a total of 473 students in all. 420 without Preschool
- Mrs. Robinson retired which would put us down to 1 teacher for fourth. Moved Mrs. Farley up to fourth grade to have 2 teachers in fourth grade

2.0 Budget Updates

- With the Covid-19 pandemic we have budget cuts
- Lost SB 178 funds (which we were paying a teacher from (Ms. Merkel)
- We were losing Read by grade 3 strategist (Mrs. Peterson) CCSD District found a way to maintain our Read by grade 3 and SB 178 (so we are able to keep Mrs. Peterson & Ms. Merkel)
- Elementary will lose \$125 per student. So for us means losing \$56,000. Saving the CCSD District about 40 million
- We will find out more September 17, 2020

3.0 Distance Learning

- First day of school Canvas crashed. Our Teachers & Staff were ready with backup plan and sent out links to all parent via dojo so our teachers can continue on with first day of school
- CCSD District has provided all the supports for Distance Learning
- Parents and students are still learning Asynchronous (Independent work) and Synchronous (Live with teacher)
- 100% of our students are accounted for. 92% of our students are in school participating
- Challenges we have encountered are connectivity (students being able to log back in)
- iPad not having the app on them (parents would come in to exchange)
- District had a security breach; they shut down as soon as they were breached. CCSD is still working on getting everything back up
- Talked about the screen time for the students (teachers are getting acclimated to their schedules to ensure safety for our students, as well as making sure assignments are online and offline
- Teachers are working on getting students used to logging off and on
- Looking to see if there is a way students cannot go into google meet before their set time
- Will check into the rule of thumb to suggest to our families for the distance of the computer screens
- Question was asked if there will be a choice between recorded or live sessions. No recorded sessions as of right now. Still looking into it
